

UNIFORM POLICY

The school encourages acceptable general standards of dress including the school's particular uniform requirements. It is the belief of this school that the wearing of school uniform fosters pride in the school, assists in the development of school tone and good conduct and reduces to a minimum undesirable dress distinction which arises when school uniform is not worn.

As well as the question of school uniforms the setting of sensible standards of dress, good grooming and personal cleanliness are especially important. School and community expectations, with regard to dress, include the need for **modesty** and the absence of offensive slogans or words on clothing or belongings. Clothing with sport logos, inappropriate language or slogans are **NOT school uniform**, and parents will be called to bring a suitable change of clothing for their child.



The school operates a Uniform Shop which P&C volunteers run. It is open each Wednesday from 2:30pm to 3:15pm. The Uniform Shop is located on the verandah facing Tongarra Road

GIRLS

Black and Gold polo shirt with school logo
